

In order to tighten up our budget a little bit here, and a little bit there, the Stonehedge dumpster will be changing. We currently have two 6-yard dumpsters which are emptied twice a week, costing us \$2,764 per month.

In the next week, we will be replacing those dumpsters with one 8-yard dumpster, with side doors. This will also be emptied twice a week at a cost of \$1,843 per month, saving a little over \$11,000 per year.

In our efforts to become more proactive than reactive, a number of electric pedestals will be replaced over the next several months. If you are on the list below, you will be contacted as to the planned date of replacement.

Pedestals to be replaced: 8/9, 51/52, 53/54,147/148,151/152, 155/156, 196/197, 200/201, 214/215, 242/243

On the day of replacement, you should consider unplugging all items that do not have a surge protector. Surges are possible. You will not need to be home on your replacement date as all work will be exterior work only.




Water meter sending units are attached to each units water meter which sends usage amounts to a program viewable by management. The purpose of monitoring water meter readings is to detect leaks before they become a problem for the homeowner and to

save on Stonehedge water expenses.

We recently replaced 48 units and the remaining nonfunctioning units, (approximately 35) will be replaced over the next several weeks.

There will be no interruption of water availability, and nothing is required from the tenant in order to complete. Please be considerate and allow the meter techs to complete the work without interruption.



A volunteer sign up sheet has been posted on the bulletin board for anyone who would like to pressure wash sidewalks for you and/or a section of your street. Everything will be set up for your use and instructions will be given on how to operate.



Tenants, please be aware that a hose could be connected to your irrigation pipe to supply water to the pressure washer.



We have moved to our cooler weather mowing schedule of every other week. Our next mow day is tomorrow, November 4th with the next service scheduled November 18th.

A new contract was signed with Spectrum for SRI provided cable/internet services. Once management receives the new channel guide, copies will be available on the table outside of the office door. A mass email will also be sent for your convenience.






