The Beacon is available in color electronically at stonehedgeonthehill.org. It will be available in a box placed at the mailboxes and inside Clubhouse.

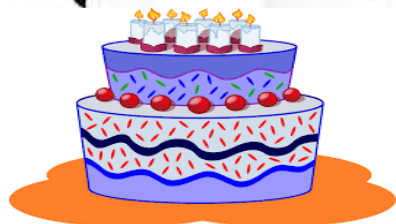

Pet Registration Reminder: Per Stonehedge Rules and Regulations

7. All dogs and cats shall be registered with the Community Manager effective March 2007. Residents must submit to the Community Manager and/or the SRI Board written evidence of rabies vaccination of their dog and adequate shots for their cat. All vaccination requests will be submitted annually in January. Ask your veterinarian for a copy of same.

Slow it down there, partner. Speed limit 15 mph

Observe the speed limit of 15 mph within the Stonehedge community. Stop at all stop signs and slow it down for the speed bumps. Do not drive on sidewalks or yards to get around speed bumps. Getting there thirty seconds earlier is not worth risking residents and guests safety, health and property. Management and residents thank you.

Code Enforcement on Patrol

Despite the increase and frequency of rain we are currently receiving, we are still in a Phase III Extreme Drought. Code Enforcement is regularly patrolling the community at various hours, including weekends. They are not issuing warnings for irrigation running on unauthorized days/hours. Several residents have already received fines. Please make sure your irrigation is running in the allotted time/day.

How 'bout them trees?

We recently completed our annual palm trimming. We also lifted tree canopies and removed dead/dying palms and trees, as well as removed hazard limbs hanging over homes. We will be continuing lifting and hazard limb removal around April 2027.



Helpful tip to owners: Palms are hungry little things. They like food, four times per year. When reviewing common area trees and palms, I noticed several homes that had weak/hungry palms in unit owned garden areas. Malnourished palms will eventually starve to death. Do your palms a favor, feed them and talking to them might not hurt.

RANCH BEER CHEESE DIP

2 packages (8oz) Cream Cheese, Softened
1 Packet (1oz.)

Hidden Valley Original Ranch Dip

BEER $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ Cup

Chopped Green Onions for Garnish

Combine cheddar cheese, cream cheese, and dip mix in a medium bowl. Gradually stir in beer until mixture is thick, creamy, and fully combined.

Tip: We recommend a fresh, soft cheddar for even melting, and a light or fruity beer that won't overpower your dip.

Garnish with green onions and more cheddar cheese. Serve with pretzels or fresh vegetable sticks.

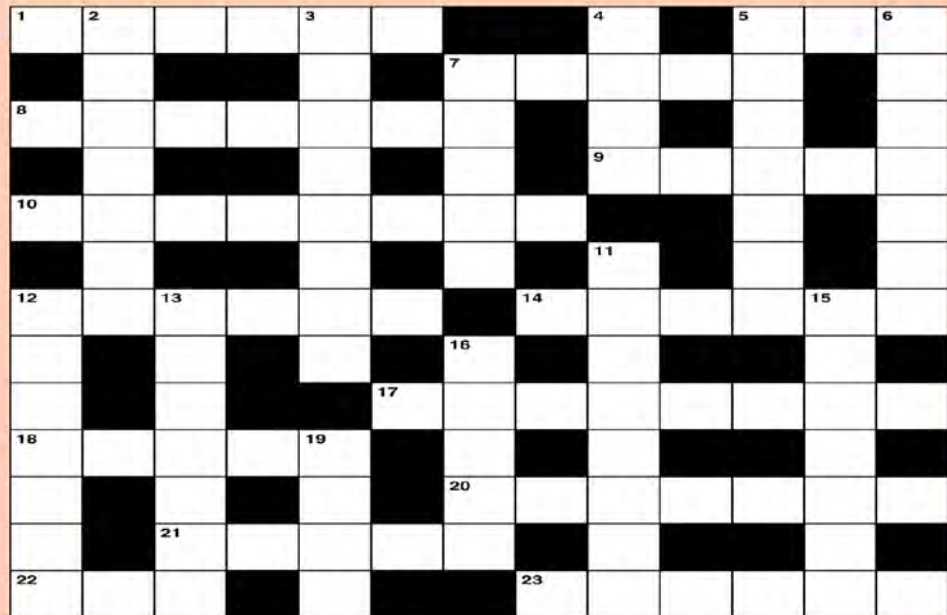

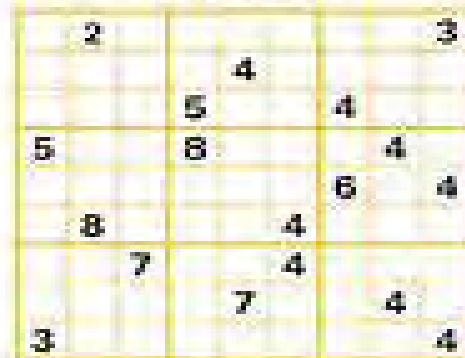

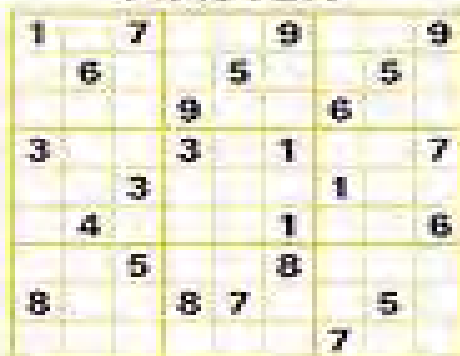
