# Watering Restriction

## District Declares Phase I Water Shortage

As of November 18, 2025, the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) has declared a Phase I Water Shortage due to dry conditions throughout the region. These restrictions are in effect December 1, 2025 through July 1, 2026.

The Phase I Water Shortage Order does not change allowable watering schedules, however it does prohibit “wasteful and unnecessary” water use, such as allowing water to flow from an unattended hose.

## Watering with Potable, Well, Lake or Pond Water

Irrigation of established lawns and landscaping is authorized for one day per week. Watering is limited to the following hours to minimize losses from evaporation:

Morning Hours: 12:01am to 8:00am

Evening Hours: 6:00pm to 11:59pm

Watering is prohibited between the hours of 8 am and 6 pm.
