<u>Secretary's Report:</u> Three reports were read, the Budget Meeting, SRI November 20, 2024 and Agenda Meeting for December 11,2024, They were discussed and approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Read, discussed and approved.

Manager's Report: Lisa presented her report to the Board and residents.

Old Business: A motion was made, seconded and approved to change the funding of the matching \$250.00 Christmas Decor to the Operating Fund.

## Committee Reports:

BMR: The replacement tiles for the pool have been chosen and are up front for residents to view.

## New Business:

ARC Requests to Make Additions /Changes: Units 219 and 57 were presented, discussed and approved by the Board.

Maintenance form will remain in use as written notice of what is happening in the park.

Roof Replacement: An advisory group is needed of residents with roofing experience to review the six bids. The bids were sent to Bill Hoffman and Mark Salisbury.

There is a partial warranty on the existing roof until April 2025that needs to be explored.

<u>Pool Water Refill:</u> options were discussed and a motion was made, seconded and approved to truck in the water to fill the pool. <u>Pool Fan Replacement:</u> Was tabled for now. The Activity Committee will explore other options.

<u>2025 Schedule of Board Meetings:</u> Will be posted in the Clubhouse.

Community Camera Proposal: Manager Curry reported on the clubhouse camera inspection and the need for additional cameras, moving and redirection of existing cameras at a cost of \$2,153.91. The proposal was discussed and a motion was made to approve. The Motion was seconded and approved by the Board.

<u>Electric Pedestal Replacement:</u> An emergency replacement of a pedestal, not part of the original Weather Chek contract, is a hazard and must be repaired at a cost of \$6,158.60 A motion was made to approve the repair, seconded and approved. The manager will request an estimate from Weather Chek of replacement contract costs for 2025.
